This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C, seeking the concession of regular bail to the petitioner in pending trial in case FIR No.17 dated 09.02.2015, under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur.

As per prosecution version, the recovery effected from the possession of petitioner was 265 grams intoxicant powder. As per report of Chemical Examiner, Punjab Government, Kharar, the same was found to be containing 'Diacetylmorphine' salt.

It has gone uncontroverted that such quantity would be construed as commercial quantity.

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Bar under Section 37 of the N.D.P.S. Act is squarely attracted in the matter. No ground for bail is made out.

Petition stands dismissed.
