Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.7 dated 19.08.2006 registered under Sections 341, 427, 34 IPC, at P.S. Sujanpur and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel states that he would not press this prayer but seeing the circumstances of the case viz. that all the other accused have been acquitted after holding that no case is made out at all, the trial Court be directed to decide the case in a time bound manner, more so since the petitioner is a student pursuing his studies abroad.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, the trial Court is directed to endeavour to decide the case as expeditiously as

possible but preferably within six months.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
