The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing of F.I.R. No.62 dated 12.9.2015 under section 395 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Mansa City-I, District Mansa.

Since quashing was sought on the basis of compromise, this Court while issuing notice of motion on 5.2.2016 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate for recording of their statements and a report as regards veracity of the compromise was called for.

Placed on record is a report dated 18.2.2016 of the learned C.J.M., Mansa and as per which the statements of the complainant Amrik Singh and the accused namely Pawan Kumar, Rajesh @ Mange Ram, Rajinder Singh, Ashok Kumar, Angrej Singh and Raj Kumar @ Raja have been duly recorded and it has been opined that a compromise has been effected without any pressure, coercion or fear. Appended along with the report are statements recorded of the complainant as also accused party.

Suffice it to submit that the allegations leveled by the complainant Amrik Singh are of having been accosted while driving in a

Scorpio vehicle on 11.9.2015 and the vehicle having been forcibly taken away along with cash and ornaments carrying a value of Rs.1,85,000/-.

Complainant Amrik Singh is represented through Mr. Sandeep Kumar, Advocate who also makes a statement that the entire recovery in pursuance to the settlement having been arrived at, has been made and he does not wish to pursue the matter.

In view of such factual position, it would be a fit case for this Court to exercise its powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C to bring to an end the criminal prosecution initiated on the basis of impugned F.I.R.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. F.I.R. No.62 dated 12.9.2015 under section 395 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Mansa City-I, District Mansa and all proceedings emanating therefrom stand quashed.

Disposed of.
