By virtue of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has sought issuance of directions to official respondents to carry out fair and impartial investigation and conclude the investigation in FIR No. 191, dated 08.10.2014, under Sections 342, 323, 452, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, Police Station Jhabal (Annexure P-1) and submit the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. before the concerned Court.

At the very outset of the arguments, it has been submitted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jugraj Singh, Police Station Jhabal that on conclusion of investigation, report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has already been presented against the 10 persons including private respondents No. 5 to 10 in the Court of Id. Jurisdictional Magistrate on 03.12.2016.

In view of the submission of report, instant petition has rendered infructuous. As such, it stands disposed of accordingly.
