Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

Mr. Jimmy Singla, Advocate appears for the respondent No.5 – brother of the petitioner No.1 and states that he and his aunt (mother's sister) may be allowed to meet petitioner No.1.

Request has been accepted. They have met the petitioner No.1 in the Chamber of this Court. Even thereafter the daughter-petitioner No.1 is adamant that she wants to live with the boy-petitioner No.2.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record

mentioned as 1997 whereas petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of Adhaar Card (Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 01.01.1989. They have also moved a representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala (Annexure P-4) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-4).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
