JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners namely Kulwant Singh and Balbir Singh in case FIR No.65 dated 31.10.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 326, 323, 324, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

As per allegations two petitioners along with two other co-accused are alleged to have inflicted injuries on the persons of complainant due to dispute qua possession over agriculture land. Complainant *inter alia* is alleged to have suffered a *datar* blow above ear on the left side of the head which has been opined to be grievous in nature. Even as per the said

version in the FIR accused-Kulwant Singh(petitioner no.1) is alleged to have caused injury on the right waist of the complainant whereas accused Balbir Singh(petitioner no.2) is empty handed and attributed a *lalkara*.

It is stated that it is a case of version and cross version wherein petitioners along with others have also suffered sharp edged/incised injuries which have been opined to be grievous in nature. He further submits that pursuant to the interim directions passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovered from them.

Learned State Counsel assisted by ASI Sardool Singh submits that petitioners have joined investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 21st of December, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
