Pursuance to the order dated 09.12.2016 passed by this Court, learned counsel for the petitioner has filed affidavit of the father of the petitioner today, in Court, which is taken on record and is marked as 'X' for identification.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

In FIR No.0086 dated 18.05.2016, under Sections 379-B(2) of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar Rural, petitioner was arrested on 29.07.2016 and is in jail since then and now seeks regular bail.

Vide order dated 09.12.2016, learned counsel for the petitioner was asked to file affidavit of the father of the petitioner that the father would be responsible, if the petitioner commits any other offence.

I have seen the order dated 29.11.2016 passed in CRM-M-

38430 of 2016 by this Court. In my opinion, there is no point in continuining the further detention of the petitioner.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. Petitioner be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence, threaten or exercise any influence on the prosecution witnesses.
