Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. by the petitioners seeking issuance of direction to respondents No. 2 & 3 to protect their lives and liberty by providing police protection who are feeling apprehension of harassment at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Pursuant to the notice of motion, it has been submitted by learned State counsel that an application dated December 18, 2015 moved by Rajwinder Kaur, one of the petitioners, was inquired into and the statements of the witnesses including petitioner-Rajwinder Kaur were also recorded and report dated December 25, 2015 has been prepared by the SHO, Police Station Amargarh.

According to the said report, the petitioners do not require any police protection as they are leading their life happily. They have no apprehension either at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6 or from any other person.

In view of the aforesaid copy of report furnished by learned State counsel, instant petition has rendered infructuous and same is dismissed as such.
