Petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.171 dated 28.09.2014, registered at Police Station Laddowal, District Ludhiana, under Sections 399, 402 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has been regularly appearing and only on one date, he could not appear and that is why his bail bonds were cancelled. Otherwise, he is ready to face the trial and undertakes not to misuse the concession of bail again.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of bail to the petitioner.

Let the petitioner surrender before the learned trial Court on 06.12.2016, which is stated to be the date fixed before that Court and in case the above assertion is found to be correct, the learned trial Court shall release him on bail to its satisfaction.

Disposed of accordingly.
