INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner, Pawan Kumar, has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.187 dated 15.10.2016, registered at Police Station Sector 11, U.T. Chandigarh, under Section 380 IPC and Sections 411 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code (added later on).

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, four heritage chairs were stolen from the balcony of residence of Warden, General Hostel, Sector 15-B, Chandigarh by Kishania and Anil etc. During the investigation, it was found that the heritage chairs were transported by Rajesh Kumar in his auto with the help of Santosh Kumar. The aforesaid

Rajesh and Santosh purchased the stolen heritage chairs @ ₹10,000/- each,

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total amounting to ₹40,000/-. It was also found that Rajesh and Santosh sold the said chairs to the present petitioner, Pawan Kumar, for a sum of ₹22,000/- each, total amounting to ₹88,000/-. It was also found that the present petitioner is the main dealer, who is involved in sale and purchase of heritage furniture.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
