JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, who has been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and (Section 326, IPC added later on), in a case arising out of FIR No.69 dated 12.05.2015, registered at Police Station "C" Division, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

The allegations are that the petitioner along with his co-accused had waylaid the complainant-Balwinder Singh and inflicted injuries upon him.

The petitioner is stated to be empty handed and attributed a *fist blow* on the stomach of the complainant.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Ratanjit Singh, concedes that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of the above, interim pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 14.12.2015, is made absolute.
