This petition under Section 482 of the Criminal Procedure Code has been filed for quashing of the order dated 10.08.2016 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Rohtak vide which application under Section 311 Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioner/accused for further cross examination of respondent No.2, has been dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that certain material questions having bearing on the matter escaped the notice of the learned counsel due to oversight.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the case file.

It is evident from the record that the accused-petitioner was afforded sufficient opportunity to cross examine the witnesses examined by the prosecution. The witness had been cross examined at length on 16.05.2016. There was no mention in the application as to which of the questions were left to be put to the witness. Learned Court below has passed a reasoned order while dismissing the application of the accused/petitioner

under Section 311 Cr.P.C.

This Court feels that no cause of action has arisen in favour of the petitioner to invoke the inherent jurisdiction of this Court. Consequently, the present petition is dismissed.
