Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents-State to take action in accordance with law in relation to representation dated 02.11.2016 (Annexure P-4) and to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of police officials of Police Station Bhagwantpura, Tehsil and District Ropar.

2. Notice of motion to the respondents-State.

3. On the asking of Court, Mr. P.S. Paul, DAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondent-State. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

4. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner has nothing to say with the registration of FIR No.45, dated 05.06.2013 and FIR No.39, dated 19.04.2016. However, still ASI Harbans Singh with the aid of some other officials, time and again raiding the house of

petitioner just to falsely implicate him.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that representation dated 02.11.2016 (Annexure P-4) was moved to Senior Superintendent of Police, Ropar but till date no action has been taken.

6. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 02.11.2016 (Annexure P-4) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
