Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral):

This order will dispose of two petitions bearing CrI. Misc. No.M-42244 of 2015 and CrI. Misc. No.M-27564 of 2014 wherein the main prayer of the petitioner is to entrust the case regarding murder of her son to the CBI.

Status report filed by the State Counsel in Court. Same is taken on record.

The complaint of the petitioner is that her young son, namely, Gurpal Singh, went missing and stated to have been murdered by some unknown persons.

The status reports filed on different dates show that the dead body of Gurpal Singh, deceased son of the petitioner, was recovered from a canal. The post mortem report shows that the cause of death of Gurpal Singh was drowning. As per the viscera report, no poisoning was found. Counsel for the respondent-State states that the cancellation report was presented before the lower court which ordered further investigation. It is stated that SIT was constituted, which has also conducted the investigation and has agreed with the previous report that it is not a case of murder. Therefore, SIT is going to file a cancellation report before the trial court.

It being so, let the final report be filed before the trial court. If the report is filed and the petitioner has some objections, she can always file protest petition against the cancellation report and if the same is filed, it shall be disposed of in accordance with law.

The petition is accordingly disposed of.
