By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioners have sought direction to respondents No. 1 to 3 to take appropriate action against the accused persons mentioned in FIR No.64, dated 21.09.2015 as well as to add Section 326 IPC in the FIR, on the basis of X-ray report dated 18.09.2015.

2. In response to the issuance of notice of motion, status report has been filed by the respondent-State in Court today and the same is taken on record.

3. A perusal of status report transpires that Dharminder Singh-accused has been arrested in this case on 03.07.2016 whereas his co-accused namely Gopal Singh, Vikramjit Singh, Sukhwinder Singh and Deepak Thakur were granted the concession of interim bail by Ms. Priya Sood,

Additional Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur and in pursuance thereof, they have joined the investigation on 05.08.2016. Subsequently, interim order was confirmed on 16.08.2016.

4. In view of the above referred facts, this Court is of the considered view that the investigation is already in progress.

5. In the light of what has been referred to above, this Court is of the considered view that the petition has rendered infructuous. As such, the same stands disposed of accordingly.
