Petitioner is a lady who was granted bail in the year 2008 in a case registered at the instance of Jaskaran Singh alleging that he had been duped by the petitioner by a false promise to send him abroad.

During pendency of the trial, the petitioner absented on 01.02.2016 and was declared a proclaimed offender on 06.08.2016. After having been arrested on 31.08.2016, she has been in custody till date.

Investigating Officer, HC Jagmail Singh deputed to assist State counsel, is not aware of the status of the trial and is unable to inform as to how many witnesses have been examined after 31.08.2016.

In view of above said circumstances, the petitioner, who is a lady, can be granted the concession of bail.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that she will not absent herself without any sufficient cause during the entire period of trial.
