JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Anil Kumar in case FIR No.307 dated 31.10.2015 for offence punishable under Section 174A of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station City-1, Abohar, District Fazilka.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner contends that the present FIR is of consequence of the proceedings arose under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act. The petitioner has paid the entire amount. No objection certificate has also been issued by the bank.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 24.12.2015 he has joined investigation and his custodial

interrogation is not required.

Learned State Counsel assisted by HC Balbir Singh that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 24th of December, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
