JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Jagwinder Singh in case FIR No.179 dated 29.10.2015 for offence punishable under Section 307, 324, 323, 295, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code and Section 325 IPC added later on registered with Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar.

It is submitted by the petitioner that his name has been wrongly mentioned as Jaswinder Singh instead of Jagwinder Singh.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that neither the petitioner was named in the FIR nor any specific injury has been attributed to him. The grievous injury has been attributed to co-accused-Taranjot

Singh Khalsa, who is behind the bars. All injuries are simple in nature and no offence is made out under Section 307 IPC. There is no role attributed to the petitioner.

It is also admitted fact that five accused persons namely Taranjot Singh Khalsa, Kuljit Singh, Sharanjeet Singh @ Sunny, Sarabjit Singh @ Sahba and Gursharan Singh @ Ganta have since been arrested and released on bail.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Surinder Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 15th of December, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
