In FIR No. 23 dated 04.07.2015, under Sections 15/61/85 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Thulliwal, District Barnala, petitioner was arrested on 04.07.2015 and is in jail since then.

It is not in dispute that the petitioner was found in possession of 60 kgs of poppy husk, against 60 kg poppy husk non-commercial. The petitioner had already commenced three witnesses were examined on 20.02.2016. The petitioner has undergone almost 1½ years imprisonment. Learned counsel for the State fairly states that, no other case is pending against the petitioner.

In that view of the matter, bail petition is allowed. Petitioner be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence.
