Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

In FIR No.161 dated 25.9.2015, under Sections 420, 382, 323, 506, 120-B IPC, Police Station Morinda, District Rupnagar, the petitioner was arrested on 25.7.2016 and is in jail since then. Challan has been filed.

Upon careful look at the FIR and the role attributed to the petitioner Mandeep Singh, who is stated to be the servant, is that he and one another person sprayed chemical in the eyes of the victims. The allegation is about the payment made to other persons regarding some agreement to sell.

The offence is triable by the Magistrate. In that view of the matter, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial court/CJM concerned. The petitioner shall not influence the witnesses and tamper with the evidence.
