AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for

grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.32 dated

08.05.2014 registered under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Division No.8, Kailash Chowk, District Ludhiana.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the order dated 25.04.2016 the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no longer required for custodial interrogation since the matter has been settled.

Learned counsel appearing for the complainant has also accepted this fact.

Learned Additional Advocate General states that she would have no objection if the parties have compromised the matter.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 25.04.2016 is made absolute. Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
