JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Satnam Singh in case FIR No.64 dated 09.07.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 341, 382, 467, 468, 471, 506 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station City Raikot, Police District Ludhiana (Rural).

Learned Counsel for the petitioner by referring to Annexures **P-1** and **P-2** respectively contends that the FIR was a result of dishonest intention of the complainant to put unwarranted pressure on the petitioner to get his loan waived off. He further submits that in such a situation, custodial interrogation of the petitioner would not be required.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Karamjit Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 15th of December, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
