Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Harjeet Kaur in case FIR No.100 dated 30.04.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 420 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station City-1, Abohar, District Fazilka.

As per the allegations in the FIR, complainant Amandeep Singh is alleged to have paid a sum of Rs.70 lacs to co-accused Ranbir Singh, who is the husband of the present accused Harjeet Kaur for investment in Forex Trading.

The name of the petitioner has figured because Ranbir Singh is alleged to have deposited a sum of that amount in the three accounts of the petitioner.

It is contended that as such no offence is made out against the present petitioner.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurmit Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 11th of January, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
