The petitioner had been convicted by the Trial Court under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act and awarded a sentence to undergo rigorous imprisonment for one year and to pay a fine of ₹ 3,000/- and in default of payment to further undergo rigorous imprisonment for one month.
