ANITA CHAUDHRY, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 43 dated 13.03.2015 registered at Police Station Nehinanwala, District Bathinda under Sections 363, 366A, 120-B IPC.

The petitioner is married to Rajni Kaur. The allegations are that the petitioner had kidnapped the sister of his wife. The girl was away for almost a week and in the first statement given to the police she had made a totally different statement that she had gone on her own as her parents were marrying her with some one. Similar statement was made before the Magistrate but in the Court she supported the statement given by the complainant. The girl had refused her medical examination. The petitioner is in custody since 13.03.2015. The trial will take time.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
