Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of appropriate directions to official respondents not to harass the petitioner by calling upon him time and again to the police station in a complaint case bearing No. 851839 dated 19.11.2015, without any rhyme and reason.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4, only at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. Rajpreet S. Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.
4. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case representation dated December 01, 2015 (Annexure P3) moved by petitioner to Commissioner of Police-respondent No.2 is dealt with and dispose of within a stipulated period as no action is stated to have taken till date.

5. Accordingly, Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to enquire into the allegations unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated December 01, 2015 (Annexure P-3) and in case any substance is found therein, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
