The present order shall dispose of 4 writ petitions i.e CWP Nos.5381, 6151, 6499 and 6645 of 2005. The facts are being taken from ***CWP No. 5381 of 2005 titled as 'Dr. Himanshu Sareen and others Vs. State of Punjab and others'.***

In the present bunch of cases, the prayer sought is for institutional preference and for reserving the 50% seats for Postgraduate Course in the Dayanand Medical College for the students who have passed their MBBS Course in the said institution. Challenge has also been laid to the notification dated 24.03.2005 (Annexure P-3), whereby the said benefit was only given to the Government Institutions and to the notification dated 16.02.2005 (Annexure P-2), which provides for reservation of 60% seats for in service PCMS candidates.

A period of more than a decade has gone by. The petitioners would have in the meantime obtained admissions elsewhere and improved their academics qualifications. The present dispute as such now has been rendered infructuous by sheer efflux of time as no interim orders of admissions to the tune of 50% reservation and admission on that basis were passed in favour of the petitioners.

Resultantly, present writ petitions are disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
