INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Jakir has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.186 dated 20.08.2016, registered at Police Station Ferozepur Jhirka, District Mewat, under Section 489-B and 489-C of Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case.

Mr. Vikramjit Singh, Addl. Advocate General, Haryana, has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record. Police record is also available.

From the record, I find that as per prosecution version, fake currency notes of Rs.10,000/- in the denomination of 100 have been recovered by the police party on the basis of secret information. The petitioner is in custody since 20.08.2016. Challan has already been presented. The petitioner is not required for any investigation or

interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.40,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
