The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for seeking direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and for direction to respondent No.3 to investigate the matter for registration of FIR and take appropriate legal action on the representation dated 08.11.2016 (Annexure P-3)

A perusal of the representation (Annexure P-1) shows that on 21.09.2016, the respondents No.4 to 8 had raised a lalkara outside the house of the petitioner and forcibly entered in her house and had beaten her husband and when she tried to stop them, they kidnapped her and kept her at a strange place. Respondents No.4 to 8 also grabbed the gold ornaments and cash of Rs.10,000/- and a mobile phone from the petitioner.

This petition at this stage is dismissed by giving liberty to the petitioner to make an application under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. before the Magistrate concerned along with medical certificate of the victim if any, for registration of FIR in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in case **Sakiri Vasu vs State Of U.P. And Others, 2008(1)RCR (Criminal) 392.**
