JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J. (Oral)

The instant petition has been preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.541 dated 26.09.2016, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 419 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, at P.S. Hodal, Distt. Palwal.

Contends that no injury has been attributed to the petitioner. The main accused, Indu Bala as well as similarly placed co-accused, Satnam S/o Diwan Singh, have already been enlarged on bail. The petitioner is in custody since 28.09.2016. The name of the property dealer who alleged introduced the complainant to Rekha Gupta has not come on record.

On the other hand learned State counsel has opposed the present petition. It is informed that the challan has been presented and the matter is now fixed for framing of charges.

Heard.

Considering the fact that co-accused Indu Bala and Satnam S/o Diwan Singh, have already been released on bail; the petitioner is in custody

since 28.09.2016; and though the challan has been presented but the charges are yet to be framed, therefore, it can safely be inferred that the trial is not likely to be concluded in the near future; without adverting to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

However, anything noticed hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
