KULDIP SINGH, J (ORAL)

The prayer in this present petition filed under Section 482 of Cr. P.C is for quashing of FIR No. 43 dated 30.04.2015 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Phase XI, Mohali, District Mohali alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising there from on the basis of compromise deed dated 03.12.2015 (*Annexure P-2*).

Report of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali, has been received wherein it has been reported that the statements of the complainant and accused have been recorded and compromise has been effected between the

parties. It is further reported that the said compromise is voluntary and is without any coercion, pressure or undue influence.

Since, the parties have amicably settled their money dispute, therefore, FIR No. 43 dated 30.04.2015 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Phase XI, Mohali, District Mohali alongwith all subsequent proceedings, on the basis of compromise deed dated 03.12.2015 (*Annexure P-2*), stand quashed.

It is stated that in view of the aforementioned compromise deed, a sum of ₹20.00 lacs was deposited in the Court of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Mohali. The same is ordered to be released, alongwith interest, if any, in favour of the respondent Nos. 2 and 3 namely Gourav Kansal and Abhishek Kansal both sons of P.D. Gupta.

In view of the above, the petition stands allowed.
