The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 21.08.2015 in a case registered at the instance of Lakhwinder Singh alleging that the petitioner in connivance with three other co-accused had duped the complainant of a sum of Rs. 6 lacs on the pretext of sending the complainant to England. Neither he was sent to England nor money was returned. Petitioner along with Gurwant Singh is facing trial.

Challan has already been presented.

In view of said circumstances, the petitioner can be granted concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the following conditions:

1. Petitioner will not commit similar offence of which he is accused of during pendency of the trial; and
2. Petitioner will not leave India without the permission of the Court and surrender his passport in the Court before he is released.
