JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Prayer is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No. 127, dated 27.07.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 302 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Guhla, District Kaithal.

It is contended that the fight had occurred on the spur of the movement on account of water being accumulated towards the house of the accused party due to the bath taken by Amarjeet, the *Saala* of the complainant-Bhola Ram. Deceased-Meeto Devi alongwith her husband-Bhola Ram was visiting her parental home, which comprises the complainant party. In the quarrel, Jaggu Ram gave a *Bhala* blow on the head of the Meeto Devi, resulting her death. The petitioner/accused-Paramjeet is attributed a simple injury with a sharp edged *Dranti* on the complainant-Bhola Ram, husband of the deceased.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 28.07.2015 and co-accused-Kalia, attributed the similar role, has since been granted regular bail vide order dated 10.12.2015, passed by this Court.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Satbir and counsel for the complainant do not refute the above said factual contention.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the facts noticed above; custody period of the petitioner and parity of treatment, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner/accused in custody, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
