The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 for providing adequate security to the petitioners.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Mehar Singh, submits that the statement of the girl-Jasvir Kaur (petitioner No.1) has been recorded wherein she has submitted that she does not fear any threat to her life. Copy of the statement filed by learned State counsel is taken on record.

Considering the submissions made by petitioner No.1 (Jasvir Kaur), the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2, Superintendent of Police, Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar that in case the petitioners move an application before him seeking protection for their life and liberty, he will look into the matter and provide necessary protection to them, if he is satisfied that the life and liberty of the petitioners is in danger at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.
