ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

This is the second petition filed by the petitioner seeking regular bail in FIR No. 58 dated 07.03.2016, registered under Sections 304-B/34 IPC, Police Station Rania, District Sirsa.

Counsel for the petitioner urges that the petitioner is in custody since March, 2016 and the cause of death was not given in the postmortem report and it was awaiting the FSL report and the FSL report has been received, which says that no poison was found and the cause of death now given was hyxia due to aspiration of large food particles.

The incident had occurred after four years of marriage. No poison has been found. There was no mark of injury in the postmortem report. After going through the chemical examination report and the visra

report, the doctors have given its opinion Annexure P-2. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
