Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.PC on behalf of petitioner-Sukhjinder Singh in case FIR No.100 dated 18.11.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 419, 420,465, 467,468,469,471 and 120-B IPC, PS Nurmahal, District Jalandhar City.

Vide detailed order passed on 18.12.2015 interim pre-arrest bail was granted to the petitioner.

During the subsequent course of hearing, it was submitted that the parties had arrived at an amicable settlement vide a written compromise deed.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Surjit

Singh confirms the fact of an amicable settlement between the parties by way of written compromise.

In view of the above, interim pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 18.12.2015 is made absolute.
