AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.33 dated 07.05.2015 registered under Sections 22 NDPS at Police Station Normahal, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in custody for more than one and a half year and on this ground alone entitled to bail.

Learned Addl. Advocate General on instructions from ASI Ajmal

Hussain states that at this stage keeping in view the recovery of commercial quantity of contraband intoxicant powder it would appropriate to put a time cap on the trial. She has stated that the prosecution will lead its entire evidence on or before 27.10.2016 subject to the accused not obstructing the same.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, in view of the undertaking given by the learned Addl. Advocate General, it is directed that in case the prosecution does not lead its entire evidence on or before 27.10.2016 (subject to the accused not obstructing the same) the petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands dismissed in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
