**JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)**

By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioners have sought pre-arrest bail, in the event of their arrest, pertaining to FIR No.105 dated 20.11.2016, under Sections 409, 420, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station SBS Nagar, Ludhiana.

At the very outset of arguments, it has been submitted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Dharmender Singh that petitioners are not required either for interrogation or for any other purpose at this stage.

In view of the submission made by learned State counsel, the present petition has rendered infructuous and it stand disposed of accordingly. However, if the petitioners are required at any subsequent stage of investigation in this case, they be served with clear five days notice to enable them to have recourse to the remedies available to them under the law.
