The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR
No.172, dated 8.9.2016, registered under Sections 306/34 of the IPC, at
Police Station Bhargo Camp, Jalandhar City.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that two co-accused
were granted anticipatory bail and one co-accused was granted regular

Bail and the petitioner has been in custody for more than three months.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab and counsel for the complainant have accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.
