Prayer made in the instant petition, filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for transfer of preliminary enquiry being conducted by respondent No.3 to senior police officer outside the District of S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali).

Pursuant to the order dated 17.12.2015, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI-Lakhwinder Singh, suggests the name of SSP, Mohali, to whom the petitioner can hand over the suicide note.

Accordingly, the petitioner shall approach SSP, Mohali on or before 22.01.2016 and hand over the said suicide note to him, who shall ensure the safe custody of said suicide note.

With the aforesaid observation/directions, the instant petition shall stand disposed of.
