Present 2nd petition is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner-Lal Singh @ Lali in case FIR No.61 dated 11.06.2014, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered with Police Station Lakhp Ke Behram, District Ferozepur.

As per the allegations, 100 tablets of Alprazolam and 800 tablets without name were recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner, which quantity as per the FSL Report is commercial in nature.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has become infructuous in the light of the petitioner having since been acquitted of the charges by the trial Court, vide order dated 04.03.2016.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Ashwani Kumar, concedes the aforesaid factual submission.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
