The petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 and 2 to decide the representations dated 18.11.2016 and 23.11.2016 (Annexures P-7 and P-9) and further for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.4 and 5 to investigate the case FIR No.196 dated 15.11.2016, registered under Sections 307, 447, 427, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act fairly.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, (Rural), Jagraon District Ludhiana, to look into the matter and take appropriate action on his representation (Annexure P-7) within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. Respondent No.3-the Senior Superintendent of Police, (Rural), Jagraon District Ludhiana is directed to look into the matter and in case it is found that any action is required, to
