This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.25 dated 25.05.2015, under Sections 21, 29 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act (for short 'NDPS Act'), registered at Police Station Khalra, District Tarn Taran.

On 23.02.2016, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“During the course of arguments, it has gone uncontroverted that there was no recovery effected from the present petitioner and he is being implicated on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused, Bohar Singh.

List on 17.05.2016.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before Investigating Officer and to join investigation.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from HC Hardeep Singh would apprise the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation. Petitioner is not stated to be involved in any other case under the NDPS Act.

In view of the above, prayer made in the present petition is accepted.

Order dated 23.02.2016, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
