This is a petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to get the matter investigated thoroughly in FIR No.187, dated 18.09.2016, under Section 306 & 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Pattran, District Patiala from some senior officers or any independent investigating agency.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 – State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though representation dated November 08, 2016 (Annexure P-2) was moved, but till date no substantive action has been taken by the concerned authorities.

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At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that she feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala (Punjab) to decide her representation dated November 08, 2016 (Annexure P-2) within a stipulated period.

The instant petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala (Punjab) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her representation dated November 08, 2016 (Annexure P-2) and if some substance is found, to take an appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
