Present petition is directed against the order passed by the court below whereby complaint preferred by the petitioner has been dismissed.

Petitioner, who is complaintant in this case, alleged that accused had entered his house and assaulted him and his wife. In support of the allegation, three witnesses were examined in the preliminary evidence. Petitioner was examined as CW/2, his wife as CW/1 and a doctor was also examined. Trial court, however, came to the conclusion that there was civil dispute pending between the parties. Complaint has been filed only with a view to settle the same. On a revision being filed before the revisional court, it came to the same conclusion.

I find no infirmity with the orders passed by the courts below. Admittedly, some civil litigation is going on between the parties. Complaint was filed during pendency of same. No fault is thus found in the findings of the courts below. Dismissed.
