The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C praying for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.388 dated 24.5.2015 under section 20 of N.D.P.S Act, registered at Police Station, City Thanesar, District Kurukshetra.

The alleged recovery from the petitioner is of 1 kg. *Charas*.

Counsel for the petitioner would press for benefit of bail by contending that such weight was inclusive of three plastic bags and if such weight was to be excluded the alleged recovery would have to be treated as non-commercial.

Be that as it may, the alleged recovery from the conscious possession of the petitioner is heavy in nature.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Ramesh Kumar would inform the Court that the trial is nearing completion inasmuch as out of the total 17 prosecution witnesses cited, 12 have already been examined.

Under such circumstances, present petition is dismissed as not pressed, at this stage.
