Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.847 dated 27.12.2015, under Sections 147/148/149/323/365 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector-5, Gurgaon, District Gurgaon.

FIR was registered on the statement of Sandeep S/o Mange Ram. Allegations pertain to an alleged occurrence that took place on 26.12.2015. Allegations are against 5/6 unnamed occupants in a silver Santro car who were armed with sticks and are stated to have given beatings to yet another Sandeep S/o Jaipal, who was a friend of the complainant.

The complainant Sandeep S/o Mange Ram as also injured Sandeep S/o Jaipal are duly represented in Court through Mr. Ankush Choudhary, Advocate.

It has gone uncontroverted that Sandeep S/o Jaipal has only suffered simple injuries and that apart, the matter has thereafter been settled between the parties and even an affidavit reflecting a compromise has been placed on record at Annexure P-2 and the contents whereof are not disputed by the counsel appearing for the complainant/injured.

Petitioner has been in custody since 27.12.2015.

In view of the circumstances noticed hereinabove, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Accordingly, petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Gurgaon.
