Heard learned counsel for the petitioner at length.

Following is the portion in the FIR in question for which
the petitioner concerned:-

“xxxxx. Hushandeep Singh took out pistol from his dub and with intention to kill me fired a shot towards me and the bullet of the pistol hit on my left thigh while I was sitting because of that my blood was oozing, Hushandeep singh after firing hand over his pistol to Avtar Singh, Prabhjodh Singh and Sunny raised alarm that Karandeep singh has been hit by bullet upon that the assailants went from there after giving the abuses and threatening that if called the police, we would be killed and while went away from the spot in their car, they fired shot in air and raising lalkaras upon that Prabhjodh Singh called Raje Walia on call, who went to Civil Hospital and, Prabhjodh Singh and Sunny after making the arrangement of Transport got me admitted to Civil Hospital Batala and Raja Walia got us admitted where doctor gave us first aid and conducted MLR and I am under treatment, xxxxx.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner invites my attention to the medical report which I have seen. He submits that the opinion on the X-Ray report shows that the injury is simple in nature. The injury report which I have seen, shows blackening around the wound which means the same relates to the fire arm injury. The contention raised by the learned counsel for the petitioner is not acceptable. FIR therefore, shows that the petitioner's name has been mentioned as a person who had taken out the pistol and fired a shot towards the complainant.

In that view of the matter, no case is made out for grant of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to apply for regular bail.
