Prayer is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No. 176, dated 11.03.2015, for offences punishable under Sections 394, 397 of the India Penal Code read with Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Hodal, District Palwal.

As per allegations, on 10.03.2015 at around 11.30 p.m., the complainant while going on a truck, loaded with goods, was waylaid by three accused persons and they robbed the complainant at gunpoint of cash, PAN cards etc.

It is contended that the petitioner is in custody since 12.03.2015.

At the very outset, learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Mushtaq Ahmad, submits that entire evidence is over and now the case is fixed for arguments on 24.02.2016.

Keeping in view the fact that the trial is at fag end, no case for grant of bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
