Husband and wife, namely, Dalvir @ Bhatti and Manjit Kaur are seeking anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.PC in case FIR No.153 dated 16.9.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 148 IPC and 326 IPC(added subsequently), Police Station Maqsudan, District Jalandhar.

A quarrel over consumption of liquor by main accused Lakhvir, Vijay Kumar, Somlal, Kaushal and Gurdeep at the time of a Mela at Peer Baba Fateh Shah led to filing of version and cross version. In the version case 17 persons have been named as accused including the present petitioners.

It is contended that even if the allegations are taken at their face value, no role has been attributed to the petitioners.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel assisted by SI Sulakhan Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 08th of February, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
